



Wheels in motion for Lewis Park Reference Group

Council has kept its promise to form a reference group to consider the future use of the Lewis Park Skate Park. Knox Mayor Jim Penna said the terms of reference were adopted by Council on 13 May. "The community asked for Council to maintain the facility," the Mayor said. "And we made a commitment to form a reference group as part of a two-year review.

"The reference group will be formed to review and report on the performance and use of the Lewis Park Skate and BMX facility."

Knox Mayor Jim Penna said the adoption of the terms of reference was a promise delivered to the community.

"This is the next step in making sure that the community plays a vital role in the facility's future. The adoption of the terms of reference is a great starting point.

"The group will discuss management issues, benchmarking for similar facilities and consideration of ongoing improvements to the park."

The Lewis Park Skate and BMX Facility Reference Group will comprise 13 members, including park users, local residents, skate and BMX industry representatives, local Police, Youth Council representatives and Council representatives. The group will meet four times a year.

Expressions of interest for potential group members will open in June, with meetings likely to start by August.
